Delhi Open: Wild cards for Karan Singh, Manas Dhamne



Davis Cupper Karan Singh and Manas Dhamne have been awarded main draw singles wild cards for the ATP Delhi Open, which begins at the DLTA Complex here on Monday. The Delhi Lawn Tennis Association also confirmed main draw wild cards for Digvijay Pratap Singh, who was part of India's Davis Cup squad as a reserve during the recent tie against the Netherlands, along with four qualifying wild cards.

Karan's inclusion comes on the back of his role in India's victorious Davis Cup tie in Bengaluru, while 18-year-old Manas is widely regarded as one of the brightest young prospects in Indian tennis. "Karan Singh and Digvijay Pratap Singh played important roles in the recent Davis Cup campaign, and this wild card is a recognition of their contribution to the team's success," DLTA president Rohit Rajpal said in a release.

Modric saves AC Milan's blushes with late winner

Luka Modric scored a late winner for AC Milan to beat Pisa 2-1 and close the gap on Serie A leader Inter Milan to five points on Friday. Inter plays fourth-placed Juventus on Saturday.

Milan had drawn three of its last six games, including against struggling Fiorentina and Genoa, and made heavy work of a match against the second-from-bottom club that had won only one league game all season.

Ruben Loftus-Cheek got the opener just before halftime when he rose unmarked to head home a cross from the right, and Niclas Füllkrug missed a penalty as Milan took control after a slow start. However, Pisa threatened to dent the visitor's title hopes when Felipe Loyola equalised with 20 minutes left.



South Africa beat NZ by 7 wickets

South Africa rode on skipper Aiden Markram and Marco Jansen's batting and bowling exploits to beat New Zealand by seven wickets and all but qualify for the Super 8 stage of the T20 World Cup here on Saturday.

Jansen recorded career-best figures of 4/40 as South Africa restricted New Zealand to 175 for 7 after opting to bowl in the crucial match.

Mark Chapman missed his personal milestone by a narrow margin when he fell for 48 to Jansen in the 14th over, but none of the other New Zealand batters could push on after making starts.

Finn Allen (31) and Daryl Mitchell (32) were also among the runs for the Blackcaps

but they just could not find any momentum to push towards a big total.

Chasing, Markram made unbeaten 86 off 44 balls, which equalled his career-best T20I score, and Quinton de Kock scored 20 off 14 as the duo shared 62 runs off 28

balls for the opening stand, while Ryan Rickelton made 21 off 11 balls. Dewald Brevis (21 off 17) made useful contribution before the duo of Markram and David Miller (24 not out of 17) closed out the contest, reaching 178 for 3 in 17.1 overs.

The result builds on last season's fourth-place championship finish.

"As a founding Formula E team, Mahindra Racing continues to establish itself as a serious contender on the global electric racing stage," said Mahindra Racing in a statement. "Following the



result, Mahindra Racing now stands P2 overall in the Team Championship standings, highlighting the team's growing consistency

and front-running pace this season. Mortara's performance also elevates him to P3 in the Drivers' Championship," it added.

Tariq is trump card, his action is cleared by ICC: Salman Ali Agha

Skipper Salman Ali Agha on Saturday defended the unorthodox action of Usman Tariq and termed the 'pause and sling' off-spinner as the "trump card" of Pakistan against India on a tacky Premadasa pitch in the T20 World Cup match on Sunday.

Tariq showed his prowess with a three-wicket haul against the United States of America, albeit at the neighbouring Sinhalese Sports Club, and the 27-year-old could be doubly dangerous on a slower RPICS track.

"Usman is one among our 15 players, we treat him like that. You (media) people have made him big. He has been bowling very well," Agha initially tried to downplay the hype around Tariq in the pre-match press meet on Saturday.

But as the questions persisted on Tariq, Agha admitted that the off-spinner is indeed his side's primary weapon against the arch-rivals, whose batting line-up is filled with power-hitters.

"He has been bowling very well for the past few months. And he has also bowled very well in the league cricket (Pakistan Super League) he was playing before playing for Pakistan. And yes, you can say that he is a trump card for us," Agha added.

Nepal players told to focus on cricket

Nepal head coach Stuart Law on Saturday expressed disappointment over the team's 10-wicket defeat to debutants Italy, saying players had "not shown commitment" while also telling the squad to ignore the "nonsense" on social media and concentrate fully on the challenges ahead in the T20 World Cup.

Nepal, who had lit up the tournament with a spirited performance that nearly toppled two-time champions England in a high-scoring thriller here last Sunday, failed to build on that momentum and



slumped to a tame defeat against Italy when expectations were high for them to raise the bar further.

Former Australian cricketer Stuart Law said he fully understood the importance of social media in the players' lives, but stressed that during a major tournament it can become a significant distraction from their primary focus on performance.

"What we've shown is that within the group, we have leaders, and at any time



those lads can lead the team," said Coyle. "But it's not just about four captains. We're looking for everyone to show leadership, even the younger boys. By naming four captains, it lets everybody know that they're all

captains. Our strength will always be as a group. We have to be together, we have to be united," he said.

With the ISL campaign set to get underway, Jamshedpur FC will look to this quartet to guide the

team on and off the pitch, as the club aims to build a united and competitive squad for the 2025-26 season. Jamshedpur FC have announced a 28-member squad for the nine home matches at the JRD Tata

Sports Complex. The Men of Steel will begin their ISL campaign on Sunday against Mohammedan SC at the JRD Stadium, setting the tone for what many hope will be a strong turnaround season.

After the Super Cup campaign, the squad is determined to respond positively and re-establish the Furnace as one of the toughest venues in the league. Meanwhile, ISL fever gripped the city as the club has confirmed that over 11,000 tickets have already been booked till date ahead of ISL 2025-26 home opener.

This season marks a historic shift for the club as it has become the first in ISL to implement a fully digital ticketing system. All tickets are available exclusively through the district by Zomato App, offering fans a seamless and secure match-day experience.
